

Enrico Salza (Turin, 1937) was appointed Chairman of the Management Board of Intesa Sanpaolo in January 2007.

On 29 April 2004 he was nominated as Chairman of Sanpaolo IMI Group, after having held the office of Deputy Chairman since 2001.

He is an entrepreneur, Chief Executive Officer of Tecno Holding SpA and Chairman of Italconsult S.p.A. Former Chairman of the Chamber of Commerce of Turin and of Unioncamere Piemonte, he was Chief Executive Office of Cerved until 2002, U.B.S. Director in Italy and Deputy Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of "Il Sole 24 Ore" from 1971 to 1989, as well as Director of Compagnia di San Paolo. Founder and first Chairman of Confindustria Young Entrepreneurs, he is currently Honorary Chairman of ASP (Associazione Sviluppo Scientifico e Tecnologico of Piedmont) and member of the Board of Governors of ICC (International Chamber of Commerce).
