

Riccardo Varaldo (Savona, 1935) graduated in Economics at Pisa University. In 1966, he was professor at the Economics Faculty of Ancona and in 1972 he was full professor of Business Management and Economics at Pisa University where he was also Dean of the Economics Faculty from 1981 to 1987. In 1988, he moved to the Sant' Anna School for Advanced Studies where he became Director in 1993. He has been President of the School since 2005. He was Professor at the "L. Bocconi" University of Milano and Visiting Professor at the Syracuse University, N.Y. and at Salford University, U.K.. He is Honorary Professor at the Chongqing University, China. He sits on the Boards of Directors of Finmeccanica and Piaggio & C. S.p.A., is a Board member of the Italy-Japan Business Group, of the Scientific Committee of the Lucchini Foundation and of the Giuseppina Mai Foundation. He is the current President of the Italian Marketing Society and of the Association "Toscana-Cina Insieme".
